- Re-read verse 27. How does this verse apply?
- What is one take home point of application for you from this sermon and this passage?
- Consider taking time to pray, asking God that by His Spirit He would help us (A) to be doers of the Word and not hearers only (B) Exercise self-control with what we say and speak (C) to seek to reach out to and care for "orphans and widows in their affliction."
